## An attempt to identify the inhabitants of the Parish of St Anne, Hewish from the 1911 census information for Congresbury, Puxton, Wick St Lawrence and Yatton.

Earlier this year I did an article on Hewish at the time of the 1911 census. It was clear that a number of residents were missing.

The Census was taken on the night of Sunday April 2<sup>nd</sup> 1911. The returns for the Census were based on administrative parishes. Unfortunately the administrative parishes did not correspond to the ecumenical parishes. Frequently there was a reasonable correlation. For example most of the Parish of St Andrew Congresbury lies within the administrative parish of Congresbury. However the census return for Congresbury also includes parts of West Wick and the Parish of St Anne's, Hewish. It is this data that I included in my analysis earlier this year of some of the inhabitants of Hewish: but where were the rest?

In addition to those recorded in the Congresbury return, I have now been able to trace families who gave their postal address as "Hewish" and were recorded in the census areas of Puxton, Wick St Lawrence and Yatton - but with a note of caution. While the addresses were signed off by the census enumerator this is no guarantee that they actually fell within either the postal district or the Parish of St Anne, Hewish. Indeed one return from Wick St Lawrence gives the address as Congresbury, but I have included it as the precise location is unclear.

I have colour coded information for each parish and have reproduced the census data in two sections. The first section shows residents' family relationships, age, birthplace, address and household information. Many of the addresses are recorded as only "Hewish". There are no street names. So we have many names that are lost in the landscape; I cannot place where they actually lived, if indeed the house is still standing. The second section shows, where appropriate, years married; number of children, living and deceased; and occupation.

Unlike my previous records of census information for Congresbury and Hewish I have not analysed the data. However similar trends are apparent. Most residents were born outside the village, although they do tend to be more local than Congresbury residents - most having been born in Somerset. For a reason unknown to me, "Oxfordshire" was frequently entered by an enumerator when the place of birth was not entered by the Head of the Household - so as it stands if you read "Oxfordshire" as the place of birth an individual might, or might not, have been born there. Overwhelmingly, men worked on the land and most women carried out domestic tasks in the home. All appear to have worked locally. Many families had children who had died. Enumerators had their own convention for recording number of children born to a husband or wife. Some listed the information alongside the husband; others alongside the wife. I have followed the style of each enumerator.
